We are happy to accept your donation of gently used items in good condition.

**Clothing:** All types of Men's, Women's, Children's, and Infant's clothing, jackets, coats, purses, belts, ties, hats, gloves, mittens, scarves, shoes, boots, sandals.

**Antiques:** All types, collectibles, glassware, knick knacks

**Electronics:** All less than 5 years old, TV's (flat screens only with remotes), radios, DVD/VCR players, portable stereos, vacuums, small appliances

**Furniture/Decor:** Bed frames, bookcases, chairs, tables, dressers, china cabinets, couches, desks, headboards, nightstands, mirrors, wall art, pottery, table decor

**Housewares:** Kitchen items (dishes, bowls, pans, serving dishes, cups/mugs, silverware/utensils), artificial flowers/plants, blankets, curtains, hangers, linens, sewing machines, towels, vases

**Jewelry:** Fine and costume jewelry, bracelets, earrings, necklaces, pins, rings, tie tacks, watches

**Seasonal Items:** Christmas decorations, Christmas trees, ornaments, other holiday/seasonal decorations, patio furniture, pots/planters, gardening and yard tools

**Sporting Goods:** Bikes, sports equipment, yard games

**Toys:** Games, puzzles, toys

- Items with chemical components or dispensers of chemicals
- Microwaves
- Stuffed animals
